NOTIFICATION

With reference to Ministry's letter No. 1-4/2023- PN.II dated 22 September 2023. The Ministry has requested NIEPA to undertake different activities which include the following:

- 3 Analyse the issues involved and coordinate for greater participation of foreign students in Indian Institutes by leveraging the 25% supernumerary seats for foreign students, Study in India Portal etc.
- 4 Outreach activity with regard to the transformative reforms for accreditation being implemented in HEIs.
 - i) Role of HEIs in achieving the targets like 50% GER,
 - ii) Improved performance in the various parameters of Global Innovation Index(GII) to improve overall ranking in GII etc., for Viksit Bharat@2047

As a follow-up of the meeting of the Vice Chancellor with the Secretary, Department of higher education and subsequent communications from the ministry and, the detailed proposal have been submitted to the Ministry. The Ministry has conveyed in principle approval of the proposals with allocation of a consolidated amount of Rs. 1 crore. The amount of allocation is much lower than the requested amount in proposals submitted to the ministry. In view of the approval of the proposals and allocation of consolidated amount of 1 Crore for all the activities the budget and time line has been aligned accordingly. The details of proposed activities including researches with an indicative budget is given below:
